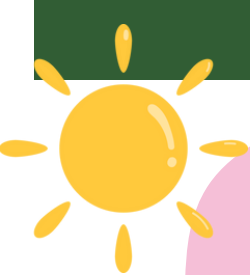
JOG-A-THON
